ADDRESSES TO THE PARTICIPANTS OF THE SYMPOSIUM

Cold regions account for more than 50% of the Earth's land area, making the construction and operation of transportation infrastructure particularly challenging.

The International Symposium on Transport Geotechnics in Cold Regions (TRANSOILCOLD), held alternately in China and Russia, always provides an opportunity for researchers and practicing engineers to share research results and experiences in designing, building and operating transportation infrastructure in cold regions.

TRANSOILCOLD was first held in 2013 in Xining, PRC, followed by TRANSOILCOLD2015 in Novosibirsk, Russia, TRANSOILCOLD2017 in Guide, PRC, TRANSOILCOLD2019 in St. Petersburg, Russia and TRANSOILCOLD2021 in Zhuhai, PRC.

The present TRANSOILCOLD2023 Symposium will be held from 02 - 05 October 2023, in Moscow, Russia, at the Russian Transport University, RUT (MIIT).

The Symposium will be held in a hybrid (online and offline) format in Russian, Chinese and English (simultaneous translation will be available).

The orientation of the symposium will be focused on "Problems and solutions in the science and practice of transport geotechnics in cold regions.
